



## E.Passport® Quick Guide

### The E.Passport:

- Is a prerequisite for obtaining the Authority to Practice Interjurisdictional Telepsychology (APIT®) issued by the PSYPACT® Commission to practice telepsychology under the Psychology Interjurisdictional Compact (PSYPACT).
- Application processing fee is \$400.00 and is non-refundable.
- Processing time is 2-3 weeks.
- Can be accessed in your credentials bank at PSYPRO.org.

### ASPPB® E.Passport Application Checklist

- ☐ **Licensure** – You must hold a current, active psychology license, based on a doctoral psychology degree in at least one participating PSYPACT state, and have no disciplinary action listed on any license.
- ☐ **Education** – Educational requirements can be met by one of six pathways based on a doctoral degree in Psychology. Official doctoral transcripts must be sent to ASPPB directly from the university or its clearing house to transcripts@asppb.org or P.O. Box 849, Tyrone, GA. 30290.
- ☐ **EPPP® Examination** – Successful completion of the EPPP exam with a score that meets or exceeds the established ASPPB recommended passing score.
- ☐ **Renewal** – To remain active, the E.Passport must be renewed annually.
