

ASPPB CEO Statement

Withdrawal of Complaint Affirms ASPPB's Commitment to Integrity and Excellence

On November 4, 2024, The Texas Behavioral Health Executive Council withdrew a complaint filed with the Federal Trade Commission on June 25, 2024, against the Association of State and Provincial Psychology Boards (ASPPB). The withdrawal of the complaint follows the change of direction to the Examination for Professional Practice in Psychology (EPPP) announced on October 22, 2024 by the ASPPB Board of Directors.

ASPPB would like to recognize the Texas Behavioral Health Executive Council for this decision and for supporting our commitment to integrity and excellence. We look forward to continuing to work with Texas and with all of our 66-member jurisdictions as we chart a new path forward exploring the feasibility of creating a single-session exam that integrates both knowledge and skills assessment—a reimagined EPPP.
